Welcome to Theme Week 6: Camouflage!

As you learned from this week's video, animals use camouflage in many different ways. These games will provide a further understanding of why using camouflage is beneficial!

In this guide you will find:

- Materials
- Step by step instructions for each game

Game 1: Pick up

Materials:

- 100 colored toothpicks
- Timer

Step 1: Mark off a small area in the yard, this is an outside game!

Step 2: Scatter the toothpicks in the area. These represent "prey".

Step 3: Have the kids (representing predators) pick up as many toothpicks as they can in twenty seconds!

Step 4: Analyze which colors were picked up and which were not as easy to find!

Questions to think about:

- Which colors were collected the most? Why?
- Which colors were collected the least? Why?
- If this game were played in the sand instead of grass which color do you think would be collected the least/most?

Game 2: Camo Hide and Seek

Materials:

- Stuffed animals

Step 1: Hide stuffed animals in the house (or outside!). Try hiding the animals in areas that they blend in, like camouflage!

Step 2: Have the kids look for where the animals are hidden!

Questions to think about:

- Were some animals easier to find than others?
- Would the animals have been found more easily had they not blended in?
